Instruction for use: 120 VAC only

1. Place the Heated Pet Mat directly on a hard flat surface inside a doghouse or kennel.
2. Plug the product directly into a 110 ~ 120 volt AC outlet. Allow one hour for the unit to warm to temperature. The product will feel warm to the touch heating up to 105 degrees Fahrenheit. Our built in thermostat will regulate the mat with the built in red indicator light showing when the product is operating.
3. Unplug, clean, and store when not in use.
4. Store indoors after winter season. Inspect cord before using. Read all instructions.
5. **Do not use extension cords.**
